

## ONLINE LEARNING OFFER

### School

- Provide quality and accessible online learning each day in case of school closure due to COVID19 lockdown, Bubble Closure and/or Self Isolation. This will be closely monitored and feedback given each day.

### Parents:

- Please support your child with online learning tasks set each day by the class teacher and provide a quiet, appropriate learning environment at home to facilitate quality input by the child. Also, engage with feedback and communication given by the class teacher in this regard on Seesaw or Class Dojo
  - Communicate positively within any online meetings (e.g. zoom) and respect the role of the teacher
  - Please do not record or photograph any online meetings with teachers to ensure privacy and data protection

### Pupils:

- Complete online learning tasks each day and do my best with each task set by my teacher when learning at home.

### Daily Online Learning Provision and Support:

Instruction sheets for parents will be available to support use of Seesaw, Purple Mash, Class Dojo, etc. These will be available on the website pages for each class.

If you require technical support through the provision of devices, please contact school and arrange to collect a loan device for your child/ren.

Class Teachers will mirror lessons which would take place in school and follow the planning so that there is a **consistent and continuous** approach to learning. Therefore, joined up learning between home and school will be facilitated.

Each day, the following learning will be provided and should be completed by each child:

Daily zoom morning meeting at 9.00am to welcome the day and cover work expected that day together with questions answered, etc.

A zoom meeting each lesson to introduce the lesson and take any feedback.

- Maths Lesson – this may be on White Rose, Online Games or Links to Websites, Worksheets for completion at home and/or pre-recorded video input from the teacher.
- English, Spelling and Grammar Lesson – this may be via Letter Join, Bug Club or Links to Websites with online games or Worksheets/ for completion at home and/or pre-recorded video from the teacher.
- Reading – a guided reading session will take place for a group of children in each class each day so that they have input at least once a week with follow up tasks for the week when other groups are online with the teacher each day.
- PE – Home Learning via video instruction or links via websites

- Topic including PSHE – this will be set each week for completion and may be in the form of a written piece of work, practical task or online activity.
- Class Novel – Teachers will upload a video to seesaw each day to continue the novel started in school.
- RE and Worship – This is either done by a task for a pre-recorded video by a member of staff or a video by Father David or Father Andrew.

Following completion of work, which will always be of a high standard, children will be able to:

- Upload evidence of the work they have done. This will often be by uploading pictures of the work to their individual portfolios on Class Dojo/Seesaw. Sometimes it may also be videos or voice recordings.
- Children can message their teacher on Seesaw/Dojo for support and help at home.

Class Teachers will:

- Provide a timetable for each week which mirrors lessons in school and expectations in this regard.
- Provide quality lessons each day to ensure there is no lost learning with teacher modelling of expectations via zoom or video for each lesson
- Give feedback to children on work completed and guidance on next steps.
- Reinforce expectations
- Follow up work not completed and communicate regularly with parents
- Celebrate successes
- Support children when needed
- Arrange for a home visit and/or phone call where there is a lack of engagement with home learning

Please work with school to ensure your child gets the most out of home learning – we understand this can sometimes be difficult, we have increased our teacher ‘live’ input to facilitate questions, request support, etc so that you feel supported at home.

Key Worker Placements

Key worker places in school are only available to those parents who have a job which falls under the category of key worker and who cannot arrange alternative child-care options. In school provision will be supporting children to access the home learning provided by the class teacher only.
