## Tutoring Funding Plan 2021-22

In 2021-22, our school has been allocated £1620 to support pupils through the recovery premium. School is expected to fund an additional 25% of the tutoring fund which is £540 (from recovery premium) which totals a spending ability of £2160 for this purpose
