These kits will be washed after use by school.


Please support us in our endeavours by ensuring your child's PE

We will begin this process from next week – **this includes parking on the staff carpark (the area just outside school)** – too many parents are now using the staff carpark every morning which impacts not only on the safety of other road users as you have to reverse out on to a busy road which has a dangerous blind bend but also this prevents staff from parking who then have to park where parents should. This also impacts on their ability to start their day on time and be in school for our children. **We ask now that all parents adhere to our request in this regard.**


IMPORTANT INFORMATION - ATTENDANCE - PLEASE READ

INTERNET SAFETY




If your child loves video games, then you'll probably be aware that how long they spend gaming can occasionally become a source of concern. The UK's trade body
